For the At-Home Learner

1. **Bedtime Stories:** These are a great way to introduce and foster a love of reading with your at-home learner and for you to stay connected! There's nothing like the bond over a good book!
 2. **Virtual Stories:** Teachers all across the country are doing virtual story time on social media platforms including youtube, facebook, Instagram, and more! Some are even doing follow-ups to their story times with matching crafts!
 3. **You can do Summer Book Club early with your learner!** Create a list of books together that your learner will read and then have them journal about the book, writing a short summary, after they finish it! You can even ask your littlest learners WH questions about the story as they read!
 4. **Adaptive Books:** If you have a learner who isn't quite ready to read on their own yet, rest assured! There are adapted books available for you! They are picture books with Velcro-picture pieces that your learner can match on the page! You can read together and talk about things they see in the pictures!
 5. **Read and Find:** Read a story with your learner, ask WH questions, and ask them to find and point to a certain item on the page!
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Aren't sure what WH Questions are? Don't fear, we've got you covered! WH Questions are simply questions that start with the letters WH. So we are talking about asking things like:

Who?

What?

Where?

When?

Why?
